LD403 Leadership Essentials

Course Syllabus for CMI Online

I. Course Description

Leadership Essentials is focused on the student as a leader in children's ministry, who is constantly growing and maturing in his or her walk with the Lord and with others. The course examines biblical principles for leadership and the personal qualities essential for a good leader. Through the DISC inventory, students will gain insights into the behavioral patterns that shape their leadership styles. Emphasis is also placed on interpersonal relationships, conflict management and communication skills necessary for effective ministry.

II. Rationale

Leading a ministry is more than activity. It is being! The Christian leader must be constantly growing and maturing in his walk with the Lord and with others. Since it has been determined that to a large extent the success of any ministry depends on the leader, it is necessary for those already involved in ministry or those considering it, to examine biblical principles for leadership and the personal qualities essential for a good leader. In addition, emphasis is placed on building relationships, time management, communication skills and managing conflict necessary for effective ministry.

IV. Course Objectives

By the conclusion of this course the student will:

- Discuss leadership topics in the forum.
- 2. Examine his or her personal leadership development as it relates to the course content in each module posting reflective summaries in journal entries.
- 3. Create a personal leadership development plan designed to promote his or her development as a Christian leader over the next year.

V. Instructional Procedures

Individual assignments and community forum discussions allow the student to interact with the curriculum on both a personal and interpersonal level. During the course, the student will meet with a mentor to allow the student to understand the qualities necessary for an effective leader and further develop a personal leadership development plan.

VII. Participation Policies

You can anticipate spending about 12-15 hours per week on course activities and assignments. All assignments including forum posts must be posted or submitted by midnight Central Standard Time (CST) of the day the assignment is due. Failure to submit any assignment on time will result in a grade reduction. In cases where the student consistently misses assignment due dates, the student may be withdrawn from the course without remuneration.

In the case of an emergency or other extenuating circumstance, students should contact their online instructor before the assignment is due and make arrangements for late submission of an assignment.

Participation on the forum and in live chats should be characterized by Christian courtesy. You may disagree with another student's (or instructor's) point of view, but please do so with respect for one another. Please read the Communication section of the student handbook for more details about communication expectations.

This course will require two meetings with a mentor. These meeting times will enable the student to discuss important leadership qualities found in effective leaders. The mentor will also help the student to assess the goals and activities that are a part of the Personal Leadership Development plan.

VIII. Grading System

During each week, there will be activities and assignments that must be completed. The text reading, presentations and activities are designed to provide information needed to complete the assignments. Students may need to do additional research as well.

It is expected that all assignments, including forum posts, be submitted on time. Failure to post forum items on time affects not only you but also your classmates and their learning. Therefore, late forum posts will negatively affect your grade. Please refer to the downloadable forum grading rubric included in the online Grading Policies and Information section of the course for information on how forums are evaluated.

Failure to submit any other assignment on time will also negatively affect your grade. In the case of an emergency or other extenuating circumstance, contact your online instructor before the assignment due date and make arrangements for a late submission.

All assignments will be graded. Each assignment will earn points that will determine the final course grade. Be sure to refer to the grading rubrics for each assignment to see how each assignment will be graded. All assignments must be completed in order to pass the course.
