

LD403 Leadership Essentials

Online Course Syllabus

I. Course Description

This course is focused on the student as a leader in children's ministry, who is constantly growing and maturing in his or her walk with the Lord and with others. The course examines biblical principles for leadership and the personal qualities essential for a good leader. Through the DISC inventory, students will gain insights into the behavioral patterns that shape their leadership styles. In addition, emphasis is placed on interpersonal relationships, conflict management and communication skills necessary for effective ministry.

II. Rationale

Leading a ministry is more than activity. It is being! The Christian leader must be constantly growing and maturing in his walk with the Lord and with others. Since it has been determined that to a large extent the success of any ministry depends on the leader, it is necessary for those already involved in ministry or those considering it, to examine biblical principles for leadership and the personal qualities essential for a good leader. In addition, emphasis is placed on building relationships, time management, communication skills and managing conflict necessary for effective ministry.

III. Instructional Methods

Individual assignments and community forum discussions allow the student to interact with the curriculum on both a personal and interpersonal level. During the course, the student will meet with a mentor to allow the student to understand the qualities necessary for an effective leader and further develop a personal leadership development plan.

IV. Learning Outcomes

By the conclusion of this course the student will:

- Discuss leadership topics in the forum.
- Examine his or her personal leadership development as it relates to the course content in each module posting reflective summaries in journal entries.
- Create a personal leadership development plan designed to promote his or her development as a Christian leader over the next year.

V. Module Learning Outcomes

Module One

1. The student will discuss leadership traits of successful Christian leaders in the forum.
2. The student will examine his or her own personal leadership development as it pertains to the biblical leadership principles in this module posting a reflective summary in a journal entry.
3. The student will create a plan to achieve a goal related to the course content that will promote his or her development as a Christian leader posting the plan in a journal entry.

Module Two

1. The student will discuss leadership principles as they relate to his or her ministry area in the forum.
2. The student will examine his or her own personal leadership development as it pertains to the biblical leadership principles in this module posting a reflective summary in a journal entry.
3. The student will create a plan to achieve a goal related to the course content that will promote his or her development as a Christian leader posting the plan in a journal entry.

Module Three

1. The student will describe three insights that will help him/her interact more effectively with others.
2. The student will describe his or her personality traits and spiritual gifts as they relate to ministry in a journal entry.
3. The student will create a plan to achieve a goal related to the course content posting the plan in a journal entry.

Module Four

1. The student will discuss in the forum important leadership skills shared during the meetings with mentors.
2. The student will examine his or her own personal leadership development as it pertains to interpersonal relationships posting a reflective summary in a journal entry.
3. The student will formulate a plan which relates to the course content in this module that will promote his/her development as a Christian leader posting the plan in a journal entry.
4. The student will assess the first half of his or her personal leadership development plan.

Module Five

1. The student will describe, analyze and propose solutions to communication problems in the forum.
2. The student will examine his or her own personal leadership development as it relates to communication posting a reflective summary in a journal entry.
3. The student will create a plan related to communication skills that will promote his or her development as a Christian leader posting the goal and the plan in a journal entry.

Module Six

1. The student will describe, analyze and discuss conflict scenarios.
2. The student will examine his/her personal leadership development as it relates to the use of conflict management styles posting a reflective summary in a journal entry.
3. The student will create a plan related to use of conflict management styles that will promote his/her development as a Christian leader posting the plan in a journal entry.

Module Seven

1. The student will discuss in the forum reasons why it is difficult to maintain a dynamic devotional life and propose ways to improve others' devotional lives.
2. The student will examine his or her own personal leadership development as it relates to his or her devotional life posting a reflective summary in a journal entry.
3. The student will create a plan related to the course content that will promote his or her development as a Christian leader posting the goal and the plan in a journal entry.

Module Eight

1. The student will share three important leadership principles discussed with the mentor in the forum.
2. The student will examine his or her own personal leadership development as it relates to time management skills posting a reflective summary in a journal entry.
3. The student will create a plan to achieve a goal related to time management that will promote his or her development as a Christian leader posting the plan in a journal entry.
4. The student will assess and finalize the personal leadership development plan that will promote his or her development as a Christian leader.

VII. Attendance/Participation
