

Ministry to Generation Z Gospel Project Rubric

This assignment is graded on a 100-point rating scale and makes up 20% of your overall grade.

A clear Gospel presentation includes teaching on our need for salvation, God's way of salvation provided through Jesus Christ, and an opportunity to respond. Because saving faith comes through the hearing of the Word of God, be sure to include Scripture for each of the following Gospel truths shared:

- Who God is (the holy and loving Creator)
- The problem/need (definition and examples of sin; all were born with a sin nature; and the punishment for sin)
- The solution/way (Jesus is the perfect Son of God took the punishment for sin, giving His blood to pay for our sin. He died, was buried, and rose back to life. He continues to live as the exalted Savior.)
- The opportunity to respond to God's invitation
